1 AN ACT Relating to removing certain requirements for vehicle 2 registration certificate applicants; reenacting and amending RCW 3 46.63.020; and repealing RCW 46.16A.050.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. RCW 46.16A.050 (Registration--Requirements 6 before issuance--Penalty--Rules) and 2010 c 161 s 405 are each 7 repealed.

8 Sec. 2. RCW 46.63.020 and 2010 c 252 s 3, 2010 c 161 s 1125, and 9 2010 c 8 s 9077 are each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

Failure to perform any act required or the performance of any act 10 11 prohibited by this title or an equivalent administrative regulation or local law, ordinance, regulation, or resolution relating to traffic 12 13 including parking, standing, stopping, and pedestrian offenses, is 14 designated as a traffic infraction and may not be classified as a 15 criminal offense, except for an offense contained in the following provisions of this title or a violation of an equivalent administrative 16 17 regulation or local law, ordinance, regulation, or resolution:
