- 1 AN ACT Relating to establishing a period of public and legislative
- 2 review of appropriations legislation; adding new sections to chapter
- 3 44.04 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 44.04 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- The legislature finds that approval of the state budget is the most important act of the legislature in any year, having profound
- 9 consequences for every resident of the state. The legislature further
- 10 finds that the public is entitled to a reasonable opportunity to learn
- 11 how public funds are proposed to be expended before bills making
- 12 appropriations become law. The legislature further finds that public
- 13 notice, dissemination of information, and informed analysis of proposed
- 14 budgets is an essential requisite of transparent, accountable
- 15 government.
- 16 The state Constitution charges the legislature, and only the
- 17 legislature, with the responsibility to fund the operation of state
- 18 government through the enactment of appropriations legislation. Yet
- 19 the abbreviated time frame in which the legislature acts on omnibus

- 1 operating appropriations legislation permits little opportunity for
- 2 informed legislative deliberation or public review and discussion,
- 3 which in turn impairs public trust in government. The legislature
- 4 finds that many other states, in their Constitutions, statutes, or
- 5 legislative rules, require a reasonable opportunity for public and
- 6 legislative review of budget legislation.
- 7 The legislature therefore finds that it is in the public interest
- 8 to provide for an appropriate period of public and legislative review
- 9 of all omnibus appropriations bills before they are acted on by the
- 10 legislature and submitted to the governor for approval.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 44.04 RCW
- 12 to read as follows:
- 13 (1) An omnibus operating, capital, or transportation appropriations
- 14 bill, may not be voted on by the senate or the house of representatives
- 15 unless seventy-two hours have elapsed since the bill was last subject
- 16 to amendment.
- 17 (2) For the purposes of this section, "amendment" means any
- 18 proposed change to a bill and includes executive action by a standing
- 19 committee of the senate or house of representatives, adoption of a
- 20 conference report, or vote to concur with an opposite house amendment.
- 21 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act shall be known and cited as the
- 22 budget sunshine act.
