- AN ACT Relating to requiring the display of the national league of families' POW/MIA flag on certain days; and amending RCW 1.20.017.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 1.20.017 and 2012 c 11 s 2 are each amended to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Each public entity ((shall)) <u>must</u> display the national league 7 of families' POW/MIA flag along with the flag of the United States and
- 8 the flag of the state upon or near the principal building of the public
- 9 entity on the following days: (a) <u>Former Prisoners of War Recognition</u>
- 10 Day on April 9th; (b) Armed Forces Day on the third Saturday in May;
- 11  $((\frac{b}{c}))$  (c) Memorial Day on the last Monday in May;  $(\frac{c}{c})$  Flag
- 12 Day on June  $14\underline{th}$ ; ((\frac{(d)}{)}) (e) Independence Day on July  $4\underline{th}$ ; ((\frac{(e)}{)}) (f)
- 13 National Korean War Veterans Armistice Day on July  $27\underline{th}$ ;  $((\frac{f}{}))$   $\underline{(g)}$
- 14 National POW/MIA Recognition Day on the third Friday in September;
- 15 ((<del>and (g)</del>)) <u>(h)</u> Veterans' Day on November 11<u>th; and (i) Pearl Harbor</u>
- 16 Remembrance Day on December 7th. If the designated day falls on a
- 17 Saturday or Sunday, then the POW/MIA flag (( $\frac{\text{will}}{\text{ol}}$ ))  $\frac{\text{must}}{\text{must}}$  be displayed on
- 18 the preceding Friday.
