1 AN ACT Relating to incrementally increasing the distribution  
2 percentage of liquor revolving fund revenues under RCW 66.08.190 to  
3 cities and counties; amending RCW 66.08.190; and providing an effective  
4 date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 66.08.190 and 2012 2nd sp.s. c 5 s 8 are each amended  
7 to read as follows:

8 (1) Prior to making distribution(~~s~~) described in subsection  
9 (~~(+2)~~) (3) of this section, (~~amounts~~) sufficient moneys must be  
10 retained to (~~support~~) fund the allotments under RCW 43.88.110 from  
11 any legislative appropriation for (~~municipal~~) city research and  
12 services. The legislative appropriation for such services (~~must be in~~  
13 ~~the amount specified~~) may not be less than the amount required under  
14 RCW 66.24.065.

15 (2) Prior to making distributions described in subsection (3) of  
16 this section, the quarterly portion of the ten million dollar amount  
17 specified in RCW 66.24.065 must be disbursed to local jurisdictions.

18 (3)(a) When excess funds are distributed during the months of June,

1 September, December, and March of each year, all moneys subject to  
2 distribution must be disbursed (~~(to border areas, counties, cities, and~~  
3 ~~towns as provided in RCW 66.24.065.~~

4 ~~(3) The amount remaining after distributions under subsections (1)~~  
5 ~~and (2) of this section must be deposited into the general fund)) as~~

6 follows:

7 (i) Three-tenths of one percent to border areas under RCW  
8 66.08.195;

9 (ii) Except as provided otherwise in (a)(iii), (iv), and (v) of  
10 this subsection, from the amount remaining after distribution under  
11 (a)(i) of this subsection:

12 (A) Fifty percent to the general fund of the state;

13 (B) Ten percent to the counties of the state; and

14 (C) Forty percent to the incorporated cities and towns of the  
15 state;

16 (iii) During fiscal year 2016 and fiscal year 2017, from the amount  
17 remaining after distribution under (a)(i) of this subsection:

18 (A) Sixty percent to the general fund of the state;

19 (B) Eight percent to the counties of the state; and

20 (C) Thirty-two percent to the incorporated cities and towns of the  
21 state;

22 (iv) During fiscal year 2018 and fiscal year 2019, from the amount  
23 remaining after distribution under (a)(i) of this subsection:

24 (A) Fifty-seven percent to the general fund of the state;

25 (B) Eight and six-tenths of one percent to the counties of the  
26 state; and

27 (C) Thirty-four and four-tenths of one percent to the incorporated  
28 cities and towns of the state;

29 (v) During fiscal year 2020 and fiscal year 2021, from the amount  
30 remaining after distribution under (a)(i) of this subsection:

31 (A) Fifty-five percent to the general fund of the state;

32 (B) Nine percent to the counties of the state; and

33 (C) Thirty-six percent to the incorporated cities and towns of the  
34 state.

35 (b) The total annual distributions to local governments under this  
36 subsection (3) may not be less than the amount required under RCW

1 66.24.065.

2 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** This act takes effect July 1, 2015.
