- 1 AN ACT Relating to food and yard waste collection space for 2 qualifying new residential occupancies with more than two dwelling
- units; and adding a new section to chapter 19.27 RCW. 3
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON: 4
- 5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 19.27 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- (1) The building code council shall, by December 1, 2014, adopt rules requiring that space be provided for the collection and periodic transfer to an off-site composting facility of food and yard waste created on-site at the following new buildings classified as 11 residential group R-2 under the state building code:
- (a) Apartment houses; 12

- (b) Assisted living facilities; 13
- 14 (c) Dormitories; and
- (d) Fraternities and sororities. 15
- 16 (2) The collection areas must be designed to meet the needs of the 17 occupancy and must, as appropriate, be available to the occupants.
- 18 (3) Rules adopted under this section must include an exemption for

- 1 new buildings located in areas that do not receive curbside collection
- 2 services of food and yard wastes in accordance with a solid waste
- 3 management plan adopted under RCW 70.95.080.
