1 On page 19, after line 35, insert the following:

2 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 10. (1) The Washington partnership council on
3 juvenile justice shall convene stakeholders to develop
4 recommendations regarding improving outcomes for individuals exiting
5 a juvenile detention facility or institution, with a focus on:

6 (a) Increasing community involvement before and after the
7 individual's exit from a juvenile detention facility or institution;

8 (b) Geographic barriers or inequities in re-entry related
9 services; and

10 (c) Re-entry related service gaps that should be addressed.

11 (2) The Washington partnership council on juvenile justice shall
12 include the following stakeholders in the requirements included in
13 this section:

14 (a) An individual who was confined in a juvenile detention
15 facility or institution;

16 (b) A family member of an individual who was confined in a
17 juvenile detention facility or institution;

18 (c) A representative of the department of children, youth, and
19 families;

20 (d) A representative of the Washington association of
21 prosecuting attorneys;

22 (e) A representative of the Washington association of sheriffs
23 and police chiefs;

24 (f) A representative of a statewide organization representing
25 criminal defense attorneys; and

26 (g) A representative from a service provider that assists
27 individuals when exiting from a juvenile detention facility or

1 institution by providing mentoring or other community involvement to
2 that individual.

3 (3)(a) By November 1, 2021 and in compliance with RCW 43.01.036,
4 the Washington partnership council on juvenile justice shall submit
5 an initial set of recommendations to the appropriate committees of
6 the legislature and the governor that describes the recommendations
7 related to improving outcomes for individuals exiting a juvenile
8 detention facility or institution as required under this section.

9 (b) By September 1, 2022, the Washington partnership council on
10 juvenile justice shall submit a final report to the appropriate
11 committees of the legislature and the governor that describes the
12 recommendations related to improving outcomes for individuals
13 exiting a juvenile detention facility or institution as required
14 under this section.

15 (4) The following definitions apply to this section:

16 (a) "Detention facility" means:

17 (i) Any detention facility as defined under RCW 13.40.020; and

18 (ii) Any juvenile correctional facility under alternative
19 administration operated under a consortium of counties under RCW
20 13.04.035.

21 (b) "Institution" has the same meaning as in RCW 13.40.020."

23 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any
24 internal references accordingly.

EFFECT: Requires the Washington partnership council on
juvenile justice to convene stakeholders to develop recommendations
regarding improving outcomes for individuals exiting a juvenile
detention facility or institution and provide a report to the
Legislature and Governor that includes these recommendations by
September 1, 2022 with an initial set of recommendations due by
November 1, 2021.

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
