EFFECT: Changes the expiration date of the temporary liquor license privileges so that the temporary privileges, the related temporary rule-making authority of the Liquor and Cannabis Board, and the related temporary tax exemption for mini-bottles of spirits sold by restaurants as part of cocktail kits, all expire one year earlier on July 1, 2022, instead of expiring on July 1, 2023.
