6 On page 3, line 8, after "purchase" strike "one hundred percent"
7 and insert ", for use in office printers and copiers, (a) one hundred
8 percent postconsumer"

10 On page 3, beginning on line 9, after "bond paper" strike all
11 material through "copiers" on line 12 and insert "~~((used in office~~
12 ~~printers and copiers))~~ or (b) paper that has at least 30 percent
13 recycled content and is certified as responsibly-sourced by a third-
14 party certification entity approved by the department of enterprise
15 services under subsection (4) of this section"

17 On page 3, beginning on line 20, after "content" strike all
18 material through "dioxide" on line 21

20 On page 3, beginning on line 24, after "utilize" strike all
21 material through "paper" on line 27 and insert "~~((one hundred percent~~
22 ~~recycled content white cut sheet bond paper))~~ paper that complies with
23 subsection (1) of this section"

25 On page 3, beginning on line 31, after "content" strike all
26 material through "agencies" on line 37 and insert "white cut sheet
27 bond paper standard, but must ~~((utilize the highest recycled content~~

1 ~~that can be utilized efficiently by such equipment and not impede the~~
2 ~~business of agencies))~~ still comply with subsection (1)(b) of this
3 section"

5 On page 3, beginning on line 39, after "agencies" strike all
6 material through "and" on page 4, line 2 and insert "~~((one hundred~~
7 ~~percent recycled))~~ paper products that comply with subsection (1) of
8 this section, and"

10 On page 4, line 4, after "agencies." insert "The department shall
11 also identify, and approve, organizations that can certify paper as
12 responsibly-sourced."

14 Correct the title.

EFFECT: Removes the option for agencies to purchase paper produced in a process that yields at least 40 percent less carbon dioxide than standard copy paper. Adds an option for agencies to purchase paper that has at least 30 percent recycled content and is also certified as responsibly-sourced by an organization approved by the Department of Enterprise Services. Requires printed projects that require the use of high-volume production inserters or high-speed digital devices that cannot use 100 percent recycled paper to use such responsibly-sourced paper. Modifies the option to buy 100 percent recycled paper by specifying that it must be 100 percent postconsumer recycled content.
