EFFECT: Provides a definition of established business relationship. Provides that a commercial electronic text message transmitted by a person with an established business relationship with the recipient does not violate certain regulations on commercial electronic text messages. Provides that commercial solicitation does not include voice communication sent by a person with an established business relationship with the recipient.
