15	the department develops a job displacement and retraining plan in

17	workforce training and education coordinating board for employees
18	whose jobs are replaced by automation."

EFFECT: Removes the bill's repeal of the restriction on regulating work-related musculoskeletal disorders and ergonomics, and instead provides that the Department of Labor and Industries may not adopt similar rules until it develops a job displacement and retraining plan for employees whose jobs are replaced by automation.
