## SENATE BILL REPORT SHB 1708

As Reported by Senate Committee On: Health & Long Term Care, February 18, 2022

**Title:** An act relating to facility fees for audio-only telemedicine.

**Brief Description:** Concerning facility fees for audio-only telemedicine.

**Sponsors:** House Committee on Health Care & Wellness (originally sponsored by Representatives Cody, Riccelli, Bateman, Macri, Tharinger and Pollet).

## **Brief Summary of Bill**

• Prohibits a hospital that is an originating site or a distant site for audioonly telemedicine from charging a facility fee.

**Background:** Audio-only telemedicine is the delivery of health care services through the use of audio-only technology, permitting real-time communication between a patient at their physical location, the "originating site", and a health care provider at a different physical location, the "distant site", for the purpose of diagnosis, consultation, or treatment.

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Audio-only telemedicine does not include the use of facsimile or electronic mail, or the delivery of health care services that are customarily delivered by audio-only technology and customarily not billed as separate services by the provider, such as sharing laboratory results.

In addition to professional fees for provider services, certain originating sites for audio-only telemedicine may charge a separate facility fee for infrastructure costs and preparation of the patient, subject to certain conditions. Distant sites and hospitals acting as originating sites may not charge the following payors a facility fee for the use of audio-only telemedicine:

- a health plan offered by a health carrier;
- a health plan offered to school or state employees;
- a Medicaid managed care plan; or
- a behavioral health administrative services organization.

**Summary of Bill:** A hospital that is an originating site or a distant site for audio-only telemedicine may not charge a facility fee, regardless of payor.

**Appropriation:** None.
