Additionally, supplemental budgets may be adopted during the biennium, making various modifications to agency appropriations.

Summary of Bill (Proposed Substitute): Appropriations are provided for certain state transportation agencies and programs for the 2021-23 fiscal biennium and are adjusted for the 2019-2021 biennium. Various appropriations and provisos are modified.
