vehicle is on public property, or at the direction of the property owner or an agent if it is on private property. A vehicle is deemed unauthorized if it is left unattended in certain public or private locations for specified periods of time.

**Summary of Bill:** The bill as referred to committee not considered.

**Summary of Bill (First Substitute):** An authorized Regional Transit Authority (RTA) representative may direct an immediate impoundment of an unauthorized vehicle on or within ten feet on either side of a right of way used by an RTA for high capacity transportation where the vehicle constitutes an obstruction to the operation of high capacity transportation vehicles or jeopardizes public safety.

Effective Date: Ninety days after adjournment of session in which bill is passed.
