BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

- field of setting penalties for violations of the controlled 8
- 9 substances act. Cities)) (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of
- 10 this section, cities, towns, and counties or other municipalities may
- 11 onlv those laws and ordinances relating to controlled
- 12 substances that are consistent with this chapter. Such
- 13 ordinances shall have the same penalties as provided for by state
- 14 law. ((<del>Local</del>)) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section,
- local laws and ordinances that are inconsistent with the requirements 15
- 16 of state law shall not be enacted and are preempted and repealed,
- 17 regardless of the nature of the code, charter, or home rule status of
- 18 the city, town, county, or municipality.
