- WAC 296-305-06513 Refueling areas. (1) Refueling pumps, if installed, must be in accordance with the provisions of the International Fire Code and WAC 296-24-33015.
- (2) Dispensing of Class 1 liquids must be as required in the International Fire Code.
- (3) Spillage of oil or fuel must be properly disposed of or completely evaporated and the fuel tank cap replaced before restarting engine.
 - (4) Fueling areas must be posted "NO SMOKING STOP YOUR MOTOR."
