BE IT RESOLVED BY THE NOXIOUS WEED CONTROL BOARD, STATE OF WASHINGTON:


Section 1. The annexed regulations, to wit: WAC 16-750-010, a proposed noxious weed list comprising the names of those plants which are found to be injurious to crops, livestock, or other property.

Section 2. This resolution and annexed regulations, after being first recorded as an administrative order in the Order Register of the Noxious Weed Control Board, shall be forwarded to the Code Reviser for filing pursuant to RCW 34.04.040 and WAC 1-12-050. Pursuant to RCW 17.10.080, a copy of the proposed list shall also be sent to each activated county noxious weed control board and to the board of county commissioners of each county having an inactive noxious weed control board.


