REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO THE USE OF INSECTICIDES ON CORN
IN EASTERN WASHINGTON

I, Donald W. Moos, Director of Agriculture of the state of Washington, by virtue of the authority vested in me under chapters 17.21 and 15.58 RCW, after due notice as provided under chapters 34.04 and 42.32 RCW, and a public hearing held in Yakima on January 4, 1972, do hereby promulgate the following regulations relating to the restricted use of insecticides on corn actively shedding pollen.

REGULATION 1. Area Under Order, Restricted Use Insecticides, and Definitions.

AREA UNDER ORDER: All irrigable lands lying east of the Cascade Crest.

RESTRICTED USE INSECTICIDES: The insecticides 1-Naphthyl-n-methyl carbamate, hereafter referred to as Carbaryl (Sevin); O,O-diethyl O-p-nitrophenyl phosphorothioate, hereafter referred to as Parathion; O,O-dimethyl O-p-nitrophenyl phosphorothioate, hereafter referred to as Methyl Parathion; O,O-dimethyl dithiophosphate of diethyl mercaptosuccinate, hereafter referred to as Malathion; Hexachlorohexahydromethano-2,4,3-benzodioxathiepin oxide, hereafter referred to as Endosulfan (Thiodan); O,O-diethyl O-(2-isopropyl-4-methyl-6-pyrimidinyl) phosphorothioate, hereafter referred to as Diazinon; S-methyl N-[(methylcarbamoyl) oxy] thioacetimidate ^{2/}, hereafter referred to as Methomyl (Lannate); and 2-chloro-1-(2,4,5-trichlorophenyl) vinyl dimethyl phosphate, hereafter referred to as Gardona, are by this order declared to be restricted use insecticides. Such insecticides are restricted in their use in eastern Washington.

DEFINITION: The term "pollen shedding corn" as related to any given cornfield regulated under this order shall be that stage of growth when 10 percent or more of the corn plants in any one quarter portion of that field are showing spike anthers.

DEFINITION: The symbols, "T", "N", "R", and "E", as related to this order shall be defined as follows: T means Township, N means North, R means Range, and E means East of Willamette Meridian.

REGULATION 2. AREA 1. (UNRESTRICTED) This area includes all irrigable lands encompassed by a line beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 34, T10N, R18E, thence North 15 miles, more or less, to the Northwest corner of Section 22, T12N, R18E; thence East 4 miles, more or less, to the Northern Pacific Railroad tracks;

thence following the tracks Southeast to the Oldenway Road; thence North along the Oldenway Road and section lines to the Yakima River; thence Southeast along the Yakima River to Highway 97, North of Toppenish; thence North along Highway 97 to Highway 410 at Buena; thence Southeasterly along Highway 410 to the Southeast corner of Section 36, T11N, R20E (Southern tip of Zillah); thence South 6 miles, more or less, to the Southeast corner of Section 36, T10N, R20E; thence 15 miles West, more or less, to the Southwest corner of Section 34, T10N, R18E, the point of beginning.

AREA 1. (RESTRICTIONS) This area is unrestricted as to the use of Carbaryl (Sevin), Parathion, Methyl Parathion, Malathion, Diazinon, Endosulfan (Thiodan), Methomyl (Lannate), and Gardona in any combination on pollen shedding corn.


REGULATION 3. AREA 2. (LATE CORN AREA) This area includes all of the irrigable lands encompassed by a line beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 18, T8N, R21E; thence North 15 miles, more or less, to the Yakima River; thence Southeast along the Yakima River to the Sunnyside-Mabton Road; thence South one mile to the Boundary Road; thence Southwest along the Boundary Road and the Yakima Indian Reservation Boundary to the Northern section line of Section 22, T8N, R22E; thence West 9 miles, more or less, to the point of beginning.

AREA 2. (RESTRICTIONS) Prior to August 1 of any given year, the application of Carbaryl (Sevin), Parathion, Methyl Parathion, and Malathion dust in any combination is prohibited on pollen shedding corn: PROVIDED, That on and after August 1 of any given year this area is unrestricted as to the use of Carbaryl (Sevin), Parathion, Methyl Parathion, Malathion, Diazinon, Endosulfan (Thiodan), Methomyl (Lannate), and Gardona on pollen shedding corn. Also, prior to August 1 of any given year, the application of Diazinon, Endosulfan (Thiodan), Methomyl (Lannate), Gardona, and Malathion liquid is prohibited between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 1:00 P.M. on pollen shedding corn.

REGULATION 4. AREA 3. (RESTRICTED) This area includes all irrigable lands east of the Cascade Crest, except for that area described in Area 1 and Area 2 of this order.

AREA 2. (RESTRICTIONS) Restrictions on pollen shedding corn. The use of Carbaryl (Sevin), Parathion, Methyl Parathion, and Malathion dust in any combination on pollen shedding corn is prohibited in the area under order. The application of Diazinon, Endosulfan (Thiodan), Methomyl (Lannate), Gardona, and Malathion liquid on pollen shedding corn is prohibited between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 1:00 P.M.: PROVIDED, That on and after September 1 of each year application of the above insecticides is prohibited between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 2:00 P.M.
