AMD WAC 16-400-006 PROMULGATION. This promulgation relates only to WAC 16-400-006, WAC 16-400-020, WAC 16-400-040 and WAC 16-400-290 of Order No. 1377.

I, Stewart Bledsoe, director of agriculture of the state of Washington, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Chapter 15.17 RCW and after due notice and public hearing held in Olympia, Washington on June 12, 1975, pursuant to RCW 34.04 do hereby promulgate the following regulations relating to horticulture inspection fees, amending WAC 16-400-006, WAC 16-400-020, WAC 16-400-040 and WAC 16-400-290 only of Order No. 1377.

AMD WAC 16-400-020 LOOSE APPLES AND/OR PEARS. (In bulk.)

- (1) \$1.25 per ton net weight or fraction thereof.
- (2) The charge for a mixture of packed and loose apples and pears, shall be based on the total of packed and loose apples and pears under WAC 16-400-010 and WAC 16-400-020.

AMD WAC 16-400-040 VEGETABLES.

Asparagus in 12 lb containers.1-1/2¢ each
Asparagus in 26 - 35 lb containers2-3/4¢ each
Corn - crates.	3¢ each
Cantaloupe (60 lb container unit).	4¢ each
Tomatoes - L.A. Lugs or loose in containers.2-1/2¢ each
Tomatoes - In flats.1-7/8¢ each
Onions	4¢ cwt.
Potatoes and seed potatoes3-1/4¢ cwt.
Potatoes where percentage grade needed or major fraction thereof (diversion program or similar program).30¢ per ton
Processing potatoes2-1/4¢ cwt.
Complete inspection (Rate reduced for service required)	


Inspection fees for cabbage, celery, lettuce, cauliflower, grapes, rhubarb, rutabagas, watermelons, squash, carrots, etc., shall be at the regular hourly rate of \$8.25 per hour, or \$16.50 for a carload, with a maximum of 2 hours time, for domestic use only.

AMD WAC 16-400-290 EFFECTIVE DATE. This order shall become effective on and after July 21, 1975.
