EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 920
(Supersedes Order No. 813)

CONTAINER MARKING REQUIREMENTS FOR SWEET CHERRIES


The adoption of this Emergency Order No. 920 establishing marking requirements for sweet cherries is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare. It is necessary that this Order become effective immediately in order that the Director provide adequate marking requirements for such fruits.

I, Joe Dwyer, Director of Agriculture of the State of Washington by virtue of the authority vested in me under Chapter 15.16 Revised Code of Washington, after due notice and public hearings held at Ellensburg on May 2, 1963, (pursuant to RCW 43.32.010 and 34.04.020), do establish the following container marking requirements for Sweet Cherries.

Regulation 1. MARKING CONTAINERS

Section 1. All containers in which sweet cherries are offered for sale for fresh consumption shall be conspicuously and legibly stamped with the name and the address of the grower, packer, or shipper, the net weight, and may be marked with the true variety name or "Sweet Cherries".
