I, JOE DWYER, Director of Agriculture, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Chapter 15.48 RCW after due notice as provided under Chapters 34.04 and 42.32 RCW and a public hearing held in Yakima on April 7, 1964, do hereby promulgate the following regulations amending Order No. 884 relating to rules for seed certification.

Regulation 1. Order No. 884, Regulation 2, Section 3 is hereby amended as follows:

Section 3. Fees for seed certification shall be as follows:

Acreage fee .....\$.50 per acre\*

\*This acreage fee shall not apply to Colonial, Astoria, Highland, and Seaside bentgrass.

Regulation 2. Order No. 884, Regulation 3, Sections 2 and 5 (1) are hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. The varieties eligible and the certification scheme for each are as follows:

Narragansett, Ranger, Rambler, Talent, and Williamsburg	Foundation seed is eligible to produce registered seed. Registered seed is eligible to produce certified seed. Certified seed is for forage production only.
Buffalo, Cody, Vernal, Alfa, Lahanton, Culver, WL-202, Teton	Foundation seed is eligible to produce certified seed. Certified seed is for forage production only.
Ladak	Foundation seed is eligible to produce registered seed. Registered seed is eligible to produce certified seed. Certified seed is eligible to produce certified seed.
DuPuits, Flamande, and Cardinal	Certified production only from approved imported seed stocks.

Section 5. Isolation requirements shall be as follows:

- Alfalfa for certification shall be isolated from all other Alfalfa varieties or fields of the same variety not meeting varietal purity requirements for certification as follows:

Breeder	Foundation	1,320 feet	1,320 feet
Foundation	Registered	1,000 feet	500 feet

Certified	Certified	300 feet	300 feet


Regulation 3. Order No. 884, Regulation 7, Section 2 is hereby amended by adding the following:

Fries groninger white clover

Regulation 4. Order No. 884, Regulation 11, Section 2 is hereby amended by deleting the following:

Olympia and Rufflyn barley and Eagle and Shasta oats.

Regulation 5. Order No. 884, Regulation 11, Section 6 is hereby amended by prohibiting vetch in the foundation class of barley, oats, wheat, and rye.
