As you know, pursuant to the provisions of Engrossed Substitute House Bill 1046, the Washington Health Services Commission will cease to exist as of July 1, 1995. Furthermore, the statutory authority for adopting chapter 245-01 and WAC 245-04-090 through 245-04-115 is repealed as of July 1, 1995.

The Washington Health Services Commission believes it will create confusion in the health care market place if these provisions are not repealed; however, due to the shortness of time between the Governor's approval of Engrossed Substitute House Bill 1046 and July 1, 1995, the statutory time frame set forth in the Administrative Procedures Act cannot be met. Thus, the Commission is requesting that you inform the Code Reviser, pursuant to the provisions of RCW 34.05.210(6) that the aforementioned rules should be removed from the Washington Administrative Code.
