

WAC 132H-160-180 REFUND POLICY. This section of WAC 132H-160 is hereby amended.





WAC 132H-160-180 REFUND POLICY. Community College District VIII

Board of Trustees has authorized the Registrar to refund fees when a student withdraws from college or a course(s). A service charge of \$5.00 will be charged for processing refunds for complete and partial withdrawals. A student who is requested to withdraw for disciplinary reasons will not be eligible for refund. No service charge required after end of matriculated registration period. (1) Tuition fees are refunded upon withdrawal from college or a course(s) as follows:

(a) Prior to the end of the matriculated registration period:

(i) Complete withdrawal from college - 100% Refunded

(ii) Withdrawal from a course(s) (reduction of class load below 10 credits) - 100% Refunded

(b) From the end of the matriculated registration period through the first week of the quarter:

(i) Complete withdrawal from college - 80% Refunded

(ii) Withdrawal from a course(s) (reduction of class load below 10 credits) - No Refund

(c) After first week of quarter:

(i) Complete withdrawal from college - No Refund

(ii) Withdrawal from a course(s) (reduction of class load below 10 credits) - No Refund

(d) Cancellation of course - Permission to transfer to another course or full refund upon request

(2) Laboratory fees are refunded upon withdrawal from college or a course(s) as follows:

(a) Prior to the end of the matriculated registration period - 100% Refunded

(b) From the end of the matriculated registration period through the first week of the quarter - 80% Refunded

(c) After first week of quarter - No Refund

(3) Parking fees are refunded upon withdrawal from college or a course(s) as follows:

(a) Prior to the end of the matriculated registration period - 100% Refunded

(b) From the end of the matriculated registration period through the first week of the quarter - 80% Refunded

(c) After first week of quarter - No Refund

(4) Insurance fees are refunded upon withdrawal from college or a course(s) as follows:

(a) Through first week of classes only - 100% Refunded

(b) After first week of classes - No Refund

(c) If insurance claim has been filed - No Refund
