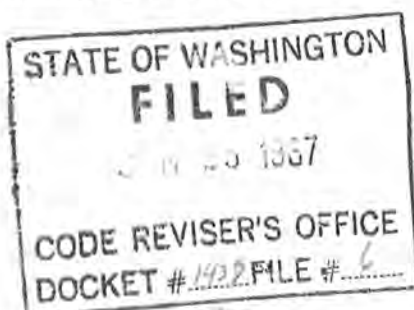

The following resolution and regulation was duly and regularly passed and adopted at a regular meeting, January 9, 1967, of the State Game Commission for the State of Washington.

RESOLVED: That the Permanent Rule and Regulation hereinafter set forth was duly ordered, adopted and promulgated by vote of the State Game Commission until further changed.

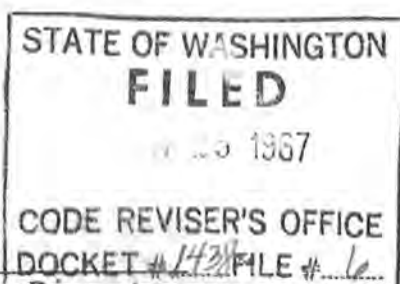
RESOLVED FURTHER: That no permit shall be issued to any person, firm or corporation to plant or release any fish into any water of the State of Washington, as provided for in RCW 77.16.150, except:

1. Under the terms and conditions of a Game Farmer's License;
2. In an aquarium designed and used for the sole purpose of displaying live fish; or
3. For the purpose of scientific research, PROVIDED, such research has previously been approved by the Director.

This regulation shall not prohibit the Director or his authorized agent from issuing a permit to plant trout into waters of the State provided that any person fishing for such fish shall possess a regular fishing license and abide by all other restrictions that would be applicable if such fish were of a native or wild strain.

The foregoing Permanent Rule and Regulation shall be forthwith entered and recorded in the minutes of the State Game Commission and published in Olympia, Thurston County, Washington, as provided by law, for one issue.

N O T I C E

The following resolution and regulation was duly and regularly passed and adopted at a special meeting, August 22, 1966, of the State Game Commission for the State of Washington.

RESOLVED: That the Temporary Rule and Regulation hereinafter set forth was duly ordered, adopted and promulgated by vote of the State Game Commission to be effective April 16, 1967.

RESOLVED FURTHER: That Temporary Regulation No. 245 shall be amended to read as follows:

That Lake Terrell, Whatcom County, is hereby classified as a "Catch and Release fishing lake" during the lawful open season in the manner as prescribed in the following provisions;

While fishing for game fish in such waters, it shall be unlawful to:

- (a) Fish from a boat, raft or any other floating device equipped with or propelled by machinery;
- (b) Use more than two (2) barbless flies attached to one line or one (1) artificial lure having attached thereto more than two (2) single barbless hooks;
- (c) Use perishable bait, double or treble hooks;
- (d) Use any barbed hooks;
- (e) Deposit any feed or other substance into this water for the purpose of attracting fish.

All game fish caught shall be at once returned to the water from whence they came with as little injury as possible.

The foregoing Temporary Regulation No. 261 shall be forthwith entered and recorded in the minutes of the State Game Commission and published at Olympia, Thurston County, Washington, as provided by law, for one issue.

N O T I C E

The following Temporary Regulation No. 262 was duly and regularly passed and adopted at a regular meeting, January 9, 1967, of the State Game Commission for the State of Washington.

RESOLVED: That the Temporary Rule and Regulation hereinafter set forth was duly ordered, adopted and promulgated by vote of the State Game Commission.

RESOLVED FURTHER: That Temporary Regulation No. 250 shall be amended to read as follows:

COUGAR OR MOUNTAIN LION SEASON:

Open Season: Year-round in all counties of the State EXCEPT CLOSED during January, February, March and April in eastern Washington.

Bag Limit: One cougar or mountain lion per calendar year EXCEPT NO BAG LIMIT in Clallam, Jefferson, Grays Harbor and Mason Counties.

Note: All cougar or mountain lion taken in Clallam, Jefferson, Grays Harbor and Mason Counties may be taken in addition to the one bag limit in the balance of the State of Washington.

The foregoing Temporary Regulation No. 262 shall be forthwith entered and recorded in the minutes of the State Game Commission and published at Olympia, Thurston County, Washington, and the Port Angeles News, Port Townsend Leader, Montesano Vidette and Shelton-Mason County Journal, as provided by law, for one issue.
