

STATE GAME COMMISSION FOR THE STATE OF WASHINGTON

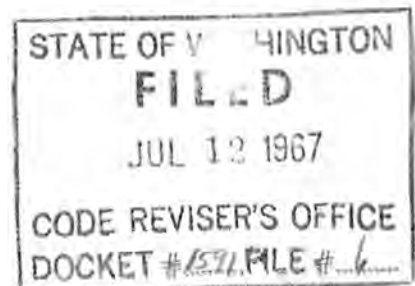

EMERGENCY TEMPORARY REGULATION NO. 267

N O T I C E

The following resolution and regulation was duly and regularly passed and adopted at a special meeting, June 26, 1967, of the State Game Commission for the State of Washington.

RESOLVED: That the Emergency Temporary Regulation herein-after set forth was duly ordered, adopted and promulgated by vote of the State Game Commission to be effective July 16, 1967.

RESOLVED FURTHER: That Temporary Regulation No. 260 shall be amended to read as follows:

It shall be lawful to fish for game fish in Bay Lake, Pierce County, State of Washington, July 16, 1967 to and including September 4, 1967.

Provided that the regular summer catch and possession limits and the six-inch size limit shall be effective during the aforesaid season.

The foregoing Emergency Temporary Regulation No. 267 shall be forthwith entered and recorded in the minutes of the Commission and published in Olympia, Thurston County, Washington, as provided by law, and in the Tacoma News Tribune, for one issue.
