Thank you and your staff, particularly Mrs. Barmore, for your assistance in this matter.

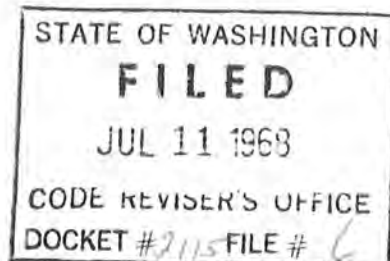

This is just a reminder that a letter of clarification is needed in feference to your Regulation No. 55 - filed May 17, 1968 and a duplicate filing which was received in this office on June 7, 1968. The Washington Administrative Code section number and caption is as follows:

WAC 232-12-550 COLLECTION OF ROCK-HOUND MATERIALS
FROM DEPARTMENT LANDS--RESTRICTIONS.

The land description and the language throughout the section differ. Your intent I believe was to correct the land description from "11" to "2". Until a letter of clarification is received this filing will be in suspense.

Please furnish us with a corrected copy of the rule and state whether or not it is intended to correct your previously filed rules dated May 17th and June 7th.
