The following resolution and regulation was duly and regularly passed and adopted at a special meeting, August 19, 1968, of the State Game Commission for the State of Washington.

RESOLVED: That the Permanent Rule and Regulation hereinafter set forth was duly ordered, adopted and promulgated by vote of the State Game Commission until further changed.

WAC 232-2-37
WAC 232-2-37 RESOLVED FURTHER: It is unlawful to fish for game fish in any irrigation canal or ditch downstream from the point where said canal or ditch leaves any river, stream or lake, to the site of any fish screen or other fish protective device when such area is posted with signs or notices closing such water to fishing.

The foregoing Permanent Rule and Regulation No. 56 shall be forthwith entered and recorded in the minutes of the Commission and published at Olympia, Thurston County, Washington, as provided by law.
