N O T I C E

The following resolution and regulation was duly and regularly passed and adopted at a regular meeting, January 6, 1969, of the State Game Commission for the State of Washington.

RESOLVED: That the Emergency Temporary Rule and Regulation hereinafter set forth was duly ordered, adopted and promulgated by vote of the State Game Commission.

RESOLVED FURTHER: That Temporary Regulation No. 277 shall be amended as follows:

That the extended 1968 bow and arrow hunting season, March 8, 1969, to March 23, 1969, established in Bow Area No. 6, comprising Mill Creek Area, Walla Walla County, with a bag limit of one (1) deer and one (1) elk of either sex, shall be declared closed.

Bow Area No. 6 - Mill Creek Area (Walla Walla County):  
That part of Walla Walla County within the following described boundary: Beginning at the junction of the Mill Creek Road with the Washington-Oregon boundary; thence easterly along the Washington-Oregon line to the Mill Creek Watershed boundary; thence northerly along the Mill Creek Watershed boundary to the Klicker Mountain Road; thence westerly along the Klicker Mountain Road to the Blue Creek drift fence; thence northwesterly along said drift fence to Blue Creek; thence down Blue Creek to its junction with the Mill Creek Road; thence southerly along the Mill Creek Road to the Washington-Oregon boundary and point of beginning,

The foregoing Emergency Temporary Regulation No. 286 shall be forthwith entered and recorded in the minutes of the Commission and published at Olympia, Thurston County, Washington, as provided by law.
