N O T I C E

The following resolution and regulation was duly and regularly passed and adopted at a special meeting, May 19, 1969, of the State Game Commission for the State of Washington.

RESOLVED: That the Temporary Rule and Regulation hereinafter set forth was duly ordered, adopted and promulgated by vote of the State Game Commission.

RESOLVED FURTHER: That ineligible applicants making application for controlled goat, mountain sheep (Bighorn sheep) or elk hunt permits shall be subject to the following penalties:

Any person applying for a controlled elk or goat hunting permit within a period of two consecutive years after having been drawn for such a permit shall automatically be disqualified for two additional years.

Any person applying for a controlled mountain sheep (bighorn sheep) hunting permit within a period of five consecutive years after having been drawn for such a permit shall automatically be disqualified for two additional years.

The foregoing Temporary Rule and Regulation No. 289 shall be forthwith entered and recorded in the minutes of the Commission and published in Olympia, Thurston County, Washington, as provided by law.
