BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GAME COMMISSION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF GAME,
STATE OF WASHINGTON:

Section 1. The annexed regulations, to-wit:

Emergency Regulation No. 298
Emergency Regulation No. 299

are hereby approved and adopted as emergency rules of the
Department of Game.

RESOLVED: That the Emergency Rule and Regulation hereinafter set forth was duly ordered, adopted and promulgated by vote of the State Game Commission to be effective as of April 19, 1970.

RESOLVED FURTHER: That Temporary Regulation No. 297 shall be amended to include the following restrictions:

It shall be unlawful to fish for game fish in Spada Lake, Snohomish County, west of the north-south section line between Sections 29 and 28, Township 29 North, Range 9 E.W.M.

It shall be unlawful to fish for game fish in Spada Lake, Snohomish County, from the shore of Spada Lake as the same rises and falls EXCEPT along the south shore of Spada Lake from the mouth of the North Fork of the Sultan River to the fishing boundary described in the aforesaid paragraph.

RESOLVED: That the Emergency Rule and Regulation hereinafter set forth was duly ordered, adopted and promulgated by vote of the State Game Commission to be effective as of

RESOLVED: That it shall be lawful to hunt raccoon, bobcat, blacktailed jack rabbit, and yellow-bellied marmot according to the following season:

OPEN SEASON: Year around, effective May 27, 1970

BAG LIMITS: No limit
