Dear Mr. White:

On April 14th, we sent you a proposed change in the By-Laws and Rules of Procedure of Washington State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors paragraph 2 under Section B Experience Records for Registered Professional Engineers, which read as follows:

"Engineering colleges outside the State of Washington are recognized by the Board only if accredited by the Engineers' Council for Professional Development. Students from engineering colleges in the State of Washington from ECPD accredited colleges are accepted. Students from other than accredited ECPD colleges may be accepted at the discretion of the Board."

At the Public Hearing held May 15th, in Seattle, the Board adopted the following change instead:

"All student's credits from curriculum approved by the Engineers' Council for Professional Development are accepted. In the State of Washington student's credits from other than curriculum approved by the Engineers' Council for Professional Development may be accepted at the discretion of the Board."
