1 AN ACT Relating to transition schools; and amending RCW
2 28A.185.040.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28A.185.040 and 1990 c 33 s 169 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 (1) The superintendent of public instruction shall contract with
7 ~~((the University of))~~ Washington state four-year public institutions of
8 higher education for the education of highly capable students below
9 eighteen years of age who are admitted or enrolled at such early
10 entrance program or transition school as are now or hereafter
11 established and maintained by the University of Washington.

12 (2) The superintendent of public instruction shall allocate
13 directly to the ~~((University of Washington))~~ four-year public
14 institutions of higher education all of the state basic education

1 allocation moneys, state categorical moneys excepting categorical
2 moneys provided for the highly capable students program under RCW
3 28A.185.010 through 28A.185.030, and federal moneys generated by a
4 student while attending an early entrance program or transition school
5 at the (~~University of Washington~~) institution. The allocations shall
6 be according to each student's school district of residence. The
7 expenditure of such moneys shall be limited to selection of students,
8 precollege instruction, special advising, and related activities
9 necessary for the support of students while attending a transition
10 school or early entrance program at the (~~University of Washington~~)
11 institution. Such allocations may be supplemented with such additional
12 payments by other parties as necessary to cover the actual and full
13 costs of such instruction and other activities.

14 (3) The provisions of subsections (1) and (2) of this section shall
15 apply during the first three years a student is attending a transition
16 school or early entrance program at the (~~University of Washington~~)
17 four-year public institution of higher education or through the
18 academic school year in which the student turns eighteen, whichever
19 occurs first. No more than thirty students shall be admitted and
20 enrolled in the transition school at (~~the University of Washington~~)
21 each institution in any one year.

22 (~~(4) The superintendent of public instruction shall adopt or amend~~
23 ~~rules pursuant to chapter 34.05 RCW implementing subsection (2) of this~~
24 ~~section before August 31, 1989.~~)
