1 AN ACT Relating to child support; and adding a new section to
2 chapter 26.18 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 26.18 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 Veterans' disability pensions or regular compensation for
7 disability incurred in or aggravated by service in the United States
8 armed forces paid by the veterans' administration shall be disclosed to
9 the court. The court may consider either type of compensation as
10 disposable income for purposes of calculating the child support
11 obligation. Aid and attendant care payments to prevent hospitalization
12 paid by the veterans' administration solely to provide physical home
13 care for a disabled veteran, and special medical compensation paid
14 under 38 U.S.C. Sec. 314 (k) through (r) to provide either special care
15 or special aids, or both, to assist with routine daily functions shall

1 also be disclosed. The court may not include either aid and attendant
2 care or special medical compensation payments in disposable income for
3 purposes of calculating the child support obligation.
