- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 87.03 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 For the purpose of issuing bonds only, the governing body of any
- 7 irrigation district may authorize the establishment of consolidated
- 8 local improvement districts. The local improvements within such
- 9 consolidated districts need not be adjoining, vicinal, or neighboring.
- 10 If the governing body orders the creation of such consolidated local
- 11 improvement districts, the moneys received from the installment payment
- 12 of the principal of and interest on assessments levied within original
- 13 local assessment districts shall be deposited in a consolidated local

- 1 improvement district bond redemption fund to be used to redeem
- 2 outstanding consolidated local improvement district bonds.
