- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 29.04 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 The secretary of state or a county auditor shall accept and file in his
- 7 or her office electronic facsimile transmissions of the following
- 8 documents:
- 9 (1) Declarations and affidavits of candidacy;
- 10 (2) County canvass reports;
- 11 (3) Candidates' pamphlet statements;
- 12 (4) Arguments for and against ballot measures that will appear in
- 13 a voters' pamphlet;
- 14 (5) Requests for recounts;

- 1 (6) Certification of candidates and measures by the secretary of
- 2 state;
- 3 (7) Direction by the secretary of state for the conduct of a
- 4 mandatory recount;
- 5 (8) Requests for absentee ballots;
- 6 (9) Any other election related document authorized by rule adopted
- 7 by the secretary of state under section 2 of this act.
- 8 The acceptance by the secretary of state or the county auditor is
- 9 conditional upon the document being filed in a timely manner, being
- 10 legible, and otherwise satisfying the requirements of state law or
- 11 rules with respect to form and content.
- 12 If the original copy of a document must be signed and a copy of the
- 13 document is filed by facsimile transmission under this section, the
- 14 original copy shall be subsequently filed with the official with whom
- 15 the facsimile was filed. The original copy shall be filed by a
- 16 deadline established by the secretary by rule. The secretary may by
- 17 rule require that the original of any document, a copy of which is
- 18 filed by facsimile transmission under this section, also be filed by a
- 19 deadline established by the secretary by rule.
- 20 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 29.04 RCW
- 21 to read as follows:
- The secretary of state shall adopt rules in accordance with chapter
- 23 34.05 RCW to implement section 1 of this act.
