Read first time March 6, 1991.

1            AN ACT Relating to teachers recruiting future teachers; adding a  
2 new section to chapter 28A.300 RCW; and creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.**    A new section is added to chapter 28A.300  
5 RCW to read as follows:

6            (1) The teachers recruiting future teachers program is created  
7 within the office of the superintendent of public instruction to help  
8 enlarge the pool of qualified high school students who are motivated to  
9 become teachers.

10           (2) Subject to funds being appropriated, the superintendent of  
11 public instruction shall:

12           (a) Promote and replicate the teachers recruiting future teachers  
13 model program; and

1 (b) Promote and expand the annual education week program on the  
2 campus of Central Washington University or on the campuses of other  
3 interested state institutions of higher education.

4 (3) The superintendent of public instruction, working with the  
5 executive director of the teachers recruiting future teachers program  
6 and the director of the education week program at Central Washington  
7 University, shall adopt rules as necessary under chapter 34.05 RCW to  
8 implement the provisions of this section.

9 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** If specific funding for the purposes of  
10 this act, referencing this act by bill number, is not provided by June  
11 30, 1991, in the omnibus appropriations act, this act shall be null and  
12 void.
