1 AN ACT Relating to city and town annexations; and creating a new
2 section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A joint select committee on city and town
5 annexations is created to be composed of six members, three of whom are
6 members of the house of representatives appointed by the chief clerk of
7 the house of representatives, with no more than two members being of
8 the same party, and three of whom are members of the senate appointed
9 by the secretary of the senate, with no more than two members being of
10 the same party.

11 The committee on city and town annexations shall review city and
12 town annexation laws on or before December 31, 1993, and shall prepare
13 a report to the legislature on these laws together with any needed
14 legislation altering these laws.

15 The committee expires on December 31, 1993.
