1 AN ACT Relating to college and university fees; and amending RCW  
2 28B.15.535.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28B.15.535 and 1992 c 231 s 15 are each amended to  
5 read as follows:

6 (1) The governing boards of the state universities, the regional  
7 universities, The Evergreen State College, and the community colleges  
8 may waive all or a portion of the tuition and services and activities  
9 fees for full-time employees or permanent part-time employees of their  
10 respective institutions of higher education enrolled in said  
11 institutions' courses on a space available basis pursuant to the  
12 following conditions:

13 (a) Employees shall register for and be enrolled in courses on a  
14 space available basis, and no new course sections shall be created as  
15 a direct result of such registration;

16 (b) Enrollment information on employees registered on a space  
17 available basis shall be maintained separately from other enrollment  
18 information and shall not be included in official enrollment reports,  
19 nor shall persons enrolled pursuant to the provisions of this section

1 be considered in any enrollment statistics which would affect budgetary  
2 determinations;

3 (c) Employees registering on a space available basis shall be  
4 charged a registration fee of not less than five dollars.

5 (2) The governing boards of the respective colleges and  
6 universities may waive all or a portion of tuition and services and  
7 activities fees for full-time intercollegiate center for nursing  
8 education, cooperative extension service, and agricultural research  
9 employees of Washington State University for such employees stationed  
10 off the Pullman, Whitman county campus: PROVIDED, That such waiver  
11 complies with the conditions spelled out in subsection (1) (a), (b),  
12 and (c) of this section.

13 (3) The governing boards of the state universities, the regional  
14 universities, and The Evergreen State College and the state board for  
15 community and technical colleges shall adopt guidelines for the  
16 implementation of institutional employee waivers granted pursuant to  
17 this section.
