1 AN ACT Relating to local voters' pamphlets; adding new sections to
2 chapter 29.81A RCW; and repealing RCW 29.81A.020 and 29.81A.080.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 29.81A RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 At least sixty days before an election, the county auditor shall
7 notify each city, town, or special taxing district located wholly
8 within that county that a local voters' pamphlet will be produced. The
9 notification shall include applicable requirements, rules, and
10 deadlines.

11 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 29.81A RCW
12 to read as follows:

13 For each measure that is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the
14 county auditor shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments
15 advocating voters' approval of the measure and shall, whenever
16 possible, formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating
17 voters' rejection of the measure. The county auditor shall appoint
18 persons known to favor the measure to serve on the committee advocating

1 approval and shall, whenever possible, appoint persons known to oppose
2 the measure to serve on the committee advocating rejection. Each
3 committee shall have not more than three members, however, a committee
4 may seek the advice of any person or persons.

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** The following acts or parts of acts are each
6 repealed:

7 (1) RCW 29.81A.020 and 1984 c 106 s 4; and

8 (2) RCW 29.81A.080 and 1984 c 106 s 10.
