1 AN ACT Relating to fees for services for the department of  
2 community, trade, and economic development; amending RCW 70.95H.040;  
3 adding new sections to chapter 43.330 RCW; and adding a new section to  
4 chapter 70.95H RCW.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.330 RCW  
7 to read as follows:

8 The department is authorized to charge reasonable fees for services  
9 and products provided under this chapter and to expend those fees for  
10 the general purposes for which they were collected.

11 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.330 RCW  
12 to read as follows:

13 The community and economic development fee account is created in  
14 the custody of the state treasurer. The department may create  
15 subaccounts as necessary. The account consists of all receipts from  
16 fees charged by the department under section 1 of this act.  
17 Expenditures from the account may be used only for the purposes of this  
18 chapter. Only the director or the director's designee may authorize

1 expenditures from the account. The account is subject to allotment  
2 procedures under chapter 43.88 RCW, but no appropriation is required  
3 for expenditures.

4 **Sec. 3.** RCW 70.95H.040 and 1991 c 319 s 206 are each amended to  
5 read as follows:

6 In order to carry out its responsibilities under this chapter, the  
7 center may:

8 (1) Receive such gifts, grants, funds, fees, and endowments, in  
9 trust or otherwise, for the use and benefit of the purposes of the  
10 center. The center may expend the same or any income therefrom  
11 according to the terms of the gifts, grants, or endowments;

12 (2) Initiate, conduct, or contract for studies and searches  
13 relating to market development for recyclable materials, including but  
14 not limited to applied research, technology transfer, and pilot  
15 demonstration projects;

16 (3) Obtain and disseminate information relating to market  
17 development for recyclable materials from other state and local  
18 agencies;

19 (4) Enter into, amend, and terminate contracts with individuals,  
20 corporations, trade associations, and research institutions for the  
21 purposes of this chapter;

22 (5) Provide grants to local governments or other public  
23 institutions to further the development of recycling markets;

24 (6) Provide business and marketing assistance to public and private  
25 sector entities within the state; (~~and~~)

26 (7) Evaluate, analyze, and make recommendations on state policies  
27 that may affect markets for recyclable materials; and

28 (8) Charge fees for services and products and expend the fees or  
29 any income therefrom for purposes of the center.

30 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 70.95H RCW  
31 to read as follows:

32 The clean Washington center fee account is created in the custody  
33 of the state treasurer. Proceeds from fees collected by the center for  
34 services and products shall be deposited into this account.  
35 Expenditures from this account may be used only for the purposes under  
36 this chapter. Only the director or the director's designee may  
37 authorize expenditures from the account. The account is subject to

1 allotment procedures under chapter 43.88 RCW, but no appropriation is  
2 required for expenditures.

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
