- AN ACT Relating to cities and towns; and amending RCW 35.27.270,
- 2 35.24.180, and 35A.12.110.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 35.27.270 and 1965 c 7 s 35.27.270 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 The town council shall meet ((on the second Tuesday)) in January
- 7 succeeding the date of the general municipal election, shall take the
- 8 oath of office, and shall hold regular meetings at least once each
- 9 month at such times as may be fixed by ordinance. Special meetings may
- 10 be called at any time by the mayor or by three ((councilmen))
- 11 <u>councilmembers</u>, by written notice ((delivered to each member at least
- 12 three hours before the time specified for the proposed meeting)) as
- 13 provided in RCW 42.30.080. No resolution or order for the payment of
- 14 money shall be passed at any other than a regular meeting. No such
- 15 resolution or order shall be valid unless passed by the votes of at
- 16 least three ((councilmen)) councilmembers.
- 17 All meetings of the council shall be held ((within the corporate
- 18 limits of the town,)) at such places as may be designated by
- 19 ((ordinance and shall)) the town council. All final actions on

- 1 resolutions and ordinances must take place within the corporate limits
- 2 of the town. All meetings of the town council must be public.
- 3 **Sec. 2.** RCW 35.24.180 and 1965 c 7 s 35.24.180 are each amended to 4 read as follows:
- 5 The city council and mayor shall meet ((on the first Tuesday)) in
- 6 January next succeeding the date of each general municipal election,
- 7 and shall take the oath of office, and shall hold regular meetings at
- 8 least once during each month but not to exceed one regular meeting in
- 9 each week, at such times as may be fixed by ordinance.
- 10 Special meetings may be called by the mayor by written notice
- 11 ((delivered to each member of the council at least three hours before
- 12 the time specified for the proposed meeting)) as provided in RCW
- 13 42.30.080. No ordinances shall be passed or contract let or entered
- 14 into, or bill for the payment of money allowed at any special meeting.
- 15 All meetings of the city council shall be held ((within the
- 16 corporate limits of the city)) at such place as may be designated by
- 17 ((ordinance)) the city council. All final actions on resolutions and
- 18 ordinances must take place within the corporate limits of the city.
- 19 All meetings of the city council must be public.
- 20 **Sec. 3.** RCW 35A.12.110 and 1979 ex.s. c 18 s 23 are each amended 21 to read as follows:
- The city council and mayor shall meet regularly, at least once a
- 23 month, at a place ((within the corporate limits of the city)) and at
- 24 such times as may be ((fixed by ordinance or resolution)) designated by
- 25 the city council. All final actions on resolutions and ordinances must
- 26 take place within the corporate limits of the city. Special meetings
- 27 may be called by the mayor or any three members of the council by
- 28 written notice delivered to each member of the council at least twenty-
- 29 four hours before the time specified for the proposed meeting. All
- 30 actions that have heretofore been taken at special council meetings
- 31 held pursuant to this section, but for which the number of hours of
- 32 notice given has been at variance with requirements of RCW 42.30.080,
- 33 are hereby validated. All council meetings shall be open to the public
- 34 except as permitted by chapter 42.30 RCW. No ordinance or resolution
- 35 shall be passed, or contract let or entered into, or bill for the
- 36 payment of money allowed at any meeting not open to the public, nor at
- 37 any public meeting the date of which is not fixed by ordinance,

resolution, or rule, unless public notice of such meeting has been 1 given by such notice to each local newspaper of general circulation and 2 to each local radio or television station, as provided in RCW 42.30.080 3 as now or hereafter amended. Meetings of the council shall be presided 4 over by the mayor, if present, or otherwise by the mayor pro tempore, 5 or deputy mayor if one has been appointed, or by a member of the 6 council selected by a majority of the council members at such meeting. 7 Appointment of a council member to preside over the meeting shall not 8 in any way abridge his right to vote on matters coming before the 9 10 council at such meeting. In the absence of the clerk, a deputy clerk or other qualified person appointed by the clerk, the mayor, or the 11 council, may perform the duties of clerk at such meeting. A journal of 12 13 all proceedings shall be kept, which shall be a public record.
