1 AN ACT Relating to divisions of the department of retirement  
2 systems; and amending RCW 41.50.050.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 41.50.050 and 1987 c 505 s 24 are each amended to read  
5 as follows:

6 The director shall:

7 (1) Have the authority to organize the department into not more  
8 than (~~two~~) three divisions, each headed by an assistant director;

9 (2) Have free access to all files and records of various funds  
10 assigned to the department and inspect and audit the files and records  
11 as deemed necessary;

12 (3) Employ personnel to carry out the general administration of the  
13 department;

14 (4) Submit an annual written report of the activities of the  
15 department to the governor and the chairs of the appropriate  
16 legislative committees with one copy to the staff of each of the  
17 committees, including recommendations for statutory changes the  
18 director believes to be desirable;

1       (5) Adopt such rules and regulations as are necessary to carry out  
2 the powers, duties, and functions of the department pursuant to the  
3 provisions of chapter 34.05 RCW.
