1 AN ACT Relating to the allocation of funds for high school students
2 enrolled in community and technical college programs; and adding a new
3 section to chapter 28A.150 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.150
6 RCW to read as follows:

7 The basic education allocation, including applicable vocational
8 entitlements and handicapped student program money, generated under
9 this chapter and under state appropriation acts by school districts for
10 students enrolled in a technical college program established by an
11 interlocal agreement under RCW 28B.50.533 shall be allocated in amounts
12 as determined by the superintendent of public instruction to the
13 serving college rather than to the school district, unless the college
14 chooses to continue to receive the allocations through the school
15 districts. This section does not apply to students enrolled in the
16 running start program established in RCW 28A.600.310.
