## SB 5351

As Passed Senate, March 7, 1995

**Title:** An act relating to requirements of cities regarding certification of family day-care provider's home facilities.

**Brief Description:** Allowing cities to require family day-care provider's home facilities loading areas to be certified by the office of child care policy licensor.

Sponsors: Senators Wojahn, Winsley, Haugen, McCaslin and Drew.

**Background:** Cities may not prohibit the use of a residential dwelling, located in an area zoned for residential or commercial use, as a family day-care provider's home facility. Cities may impose a number of requirements on the facility, one of which is that the Department of Licensing certify that the facility provides a safe passenger loading area.

**Summary of Bill:** The Office of Child Care Policy Licensor, rather than the Department of Licensing, certifies that a family day-care facility is providing a safe passenger loading area.

**Appropriation:** None.

**Fiscal Note:** Not requested.

**Effective Date:** Ninety days after adjournment of session in which bill is passed.

**Testimony For:** This is strictly an administrative change to facilitate family day-care facility services.

**Testimony Against:** None.
