- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** (1) The state auditor shall conduct a
- 6 performance audit of the office of the superintendent of public
- 7 instruction to evaluate the following:
- 8 (a) Whether the office of the superintendent of public instruction
- 9 is acquiring, protecting, and using its resources such as personnel,
- 10 property, and land economically and efficiently;
- 11 (b) The causes of inefficiencies or uneconomical practices; and
- 12 (c) Whether the entity has complied with laws and rules on matters
- 13 of economy and efficiency.
- 14 (2) The state auditor shall report its findings to the legislature

- 17 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the biennium ending

- 1 June 30, 1997, from the general fund to the state auditor for the
- 2 purposes of this act.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 4 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the

- 6 effect immediately.
