- AN ACT Relating to notice of actions against a juvenile's driver's
- 2 license; and amending RCW 46.20.292.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.20.292 and 1979 c 61 s 8 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 The department may suspend, revoke, restrict, or condition any
- 7 driver's license upon a showing of its records that the licensee has
- 8 been found by a juvenile court, chief probation officer, or any other
- 9 duly authorized officer of a juvenile court to have committed any
- 10 offense or offenses which under Title 46 RCW constitutes grounds for
- 11 said action. If the department takes any such action against the
- 12 <u>driver's license of a person under eighteen years of age who is not</u>
- 13 emancipated from his or her parent, parents, or guardian, the
- 14 department shall give notice of the action by certified mail, return
- 15 receipt requested, to the juvenile's parent, parents, or quardian.
