- 1 AN ACT Relating to health care services for offenders; amending RCW
- 2 72.10.020; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 72.10.020 and 1989 c 157 s 3 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) The department may develop and implement a health services plan
- 7 for the delivery of health care services to ((inmates)) offenders in
- 8 the department's ((custody)) correctional facilities, at the discretion
- 9 of the secretary, and in conformity with state and federal law.
- 10 (2) In order to discourage the unwarranted use of health care
- 11 services, all offenders shall participate in the costs of health care
- 12 services by paying no less than three dollars. Pursuant to the
- 13 authority granted in chapter 34.05 RCW, the secretary may collect this
- 14 amount for health care services directly from an offender's institution
- 15 <u>account</u>.
- 16 (3) Offenders are required to make copayments for health care
- 17 <u>services that are offender initiated</u>. <u>Offenders are not required to</u>
- 18 pay for emergency treatment or for visits initiated by health care

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- 1 staff or treatment of those conditions that constitute a serious health
- 2 <u>care need.</u>
- 3 (4) No offender may be refused any health care service because of
- 4 <u>indigence</u>.
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The department shall adopt rules to
- 6 implement this act.

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
