- AN ACT Relating to railroads; and amending RCW 81.48.010.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 3 **Sec. 1.** RCW 81.48.010 and 1961 c 14 s 81.48.010 are each amended 4 to read as follows:
- 5 Every engineer driving a locomotive on any railway who shall fail
- 6 to ring the bell or sound the whistle upon such locomotive, or cause
- 7 the same to be rung or sounded at least eighty rods from any place
- 8 where such railway crosses a traveled road or street on the same level
- 9 (except in cities or in counties that enact ordinances applying only to
- 10 gated crossings located within urban areas), or to continue the ringing
- 11 of such bell or sounding of such whistle until such locomotive shall
- 12 have crossed such road or street, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
