- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** Section 1, chapter ... (SHB 1047), Laws of
- 4 1995 shall apply retroactively to allow courts to set restitution in
- 5 cases sentenced prior to the effective date of section 1, chapter ...
- 6 (SHB 1047), Laws of 1995 if:
- 7 (1) The court failed to set restitution within sixty days of
- 8 sentencing as required by RCW 9.94A.140 prior to the effective date of
- 9 section 1, chapter ... (SHB 1047), Laws of 1995;
- 10 (2) The defendant was sentenced no more than three hundred sixty-
- 11 five days before the effective date of section 1, chapter ... (SHB
- 12 1047), Laws of 1995; and
- 13 (3) The defendant is not unfairly prejudiced by the delay.
- In those cases, the court may set restitution within one hundred
- 15 eighty days of the effective date of section 1, chapter ... (SHB 1047),
- 16 Laws of 1995 or at a later hearing set by the court for good cause.
