1 AN ACT Relating to vessels; amending RCW 88.12.155; reenacting and 2 amending RCW 9.94A.320; and prescribing penalties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 88.12.155 and 1993 c 244 s 18 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

(1) The operator of a vessel involved in a collision, accident, or 6 7 other casualty, to the extent the operator can do so without serious danger to the operator's own vessel or persons aboard, shall render all 8 9 and necessary assistance to persons affected by the practical 10 collision, accident, or casualty to save them from danger caused by the Under no circumstances may the rendering of assistance or 11 incident. other compliance with this section be evidence of the liability of such 12 13 operator for the collision, accident, or casualty. The operator shall 14 also give all pertinent accident information, as specified by rule by 15 the commission, to the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction: 16 PROVIDED, That this requirement shall not apply to operators of vessels 17 when they are participating in an organized competitive event 18 authorized or otherwise permitted by the appropriate agency having 19 jurisdiction and authority to authorize such events. These duties are

1 in addition to any duties otherwise imposed by law. Except as provided 2 for in RCW 88.12.015 <u>and subsection (3) of this section</u>, a violation of 3 this subsection is a civil infraction punishable under RCW 7.84.100.

4 (2) Any person who complies with subsection (1) of this section or 5 who gratuitously and in good faith renders assistance at the scene of a vessel collision, accident, or other casualty, without objection of 6 7 the person assisted, shall not be held liable for any civil damages as 8 a result of the rendering of assistance or for any act or omission in 9 providing or arranging salvage, towage, medical treatment, or other 10 assistance, where the assisting person acts as any reasonably prudent person would have acted under the same or similar circumstances. 11

(3) An operator of a vessel is guilty of a class C felony and is 12 punishable pursuant to RCW 9A.20.021 if the operator: (a) Is involved 13 in a collision that results in injury to a person; (b) knew or 14 reasonably should have known that a person was injured in the 15 collision; and (c) leaves the scene of the collision without rendering 16 all practical and necessary assistance to the injured person as 17 required pursuant to subsection (1) of this section, under 18 19 circumstances in which the operator could have rendered assistance 20 without serious danger to the operator's own vessel or persons aboard. This subsection (3) applies to collisions that occur on fresh waters 21 located within the state of Washington, except self-propelled cargo 22 23 vessel ships in commerce of three hundred or more gross tons, including 24 but not limited to commercial fishing processing vessels and 25 freighters.
