- 1 AN ACT Relating to the head injury trust fund; adding a new section
- 2 to chapter 46.61 RCW; and prescribing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1)(a) In addition to penalties set forth in RCW 46.61.5051 through
- 7 46.61.5053, a twenty-five dollar fine shall be assessed to a person who
- 8 is either convicted, sentenced to a lesser charge, or given deferred
- 9 prosecution as a result of an arrest for violating RCW 46.61.502,
- 10 46.61.504, 46.61.520, or 46.61.522. This fine is for the purpose of
- 11 providing services to persons disabled by traumatic head injuries.
- 12 (b) If a minor has been adjudicated a juvenile offender for an
- 13 offense which, if committed by an adult would constitute a violation of
- 14 RCW 46.61.502, 46.61.504, 46.61.520, or 46.61.522, the court shall
- 15 assess the twenty-five dollar fine under (a) of this subsection.
- 16 (2) The fine assessed in this section shall be collected by the
- 17 clerk of the court and forwarded to the state treasurer for deposit in
- 18 the head injury trust fund.

- (3) The head injury trust fund is created in the custody of the 1 state treasurer. All receipts from fines under subsection (1) of this 2 section shall be deposited into the fund. Expenditures from the fund 3 4 may be used only to provide services to persons disabled by traumatic head injuries. Only the director of labor and industries or the 5 director's designee may authorize expenditures from the fund. The fund 6 7 is subject to allotment procedures under chapter 43.88 RCW, but no 8 appropriation is required for expenditures.
- 9 (4) The director of labor and industries shall establish and 10 administer a program of benefits for persons disabled by traumatic head 11 injuries.
- 12 (5) For the purpose of applying for benefits under this section, 13 the rights, privileges, responsibilities, duties, limitations, and 14 procedures in RCW 51.28.020, 51.28.030, 51.28.040, and 51.28.060 apply.
- 15 (6) The right to benefits under this section and the amount thereof 16 is governed insofar as applicable by chapter 51.32 RCW.
- 17 (7) The director of labor and industries may adopt rules under 18 chapter 34.05 RCW as necessary to establish eligibility for benefits 19 and amounts under this section.
